Re-Enrollment for 2024-2025 School Year

We have reached the stage in our planning where we would like to ask you to confirm re-enrollment for your child(ren) for the coming school year. Organisation of the new school year is well underway, and we are expecting to open a number of new classes and welcome many new AIS students and families in August. As such, we want to ensure that continuing families are secured seats for their children in the new academic year, and your re-enrollment decisions are essential in this process.



We do recognise that some of you may be waiting for information regarding employment contracts and plans for your family, and this may be early for some to declare their intentions. It is absolutely ok to choose "Undecided" for now. We are asking any families who are certain of their plan for next school year, or who are a clear "Accept" or "Decline" seat for their child(ren) to please indicate this when we send the re-enrollment via Open Apply.

We expect to keep re-enrollment open until March, at which point we will follow-up directly with any undecided families, or anyone who has not responded by that time. We are appreciative of those who can already now share their re-enrollment decisions with us, as we work to put together the best possible plans for all of our students for the 2024-2025 school year.
