Language Classes for Students from EU/EEA Countries

AIS has received the following invitation from Aarhus Kommune, which is relevant to families coming from an EU or EEA country. At Møllevangskolen in Aarhus, we offer free tuition in EU languages to pupils of compulsory school age (grades 0-9 - equivalent to PYP4-MYP5 at AIS). To participate in the teaching offer, the following criteria must be met:

- One of the student's parents resides in Denmark and is a citizen of an EU or EEA country - or
- Faroese or Greenlandic is the spoken language at home.

PYP 4-8 STUDENT LED CONFERENCES 6 MAY



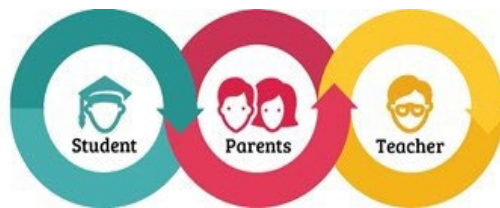

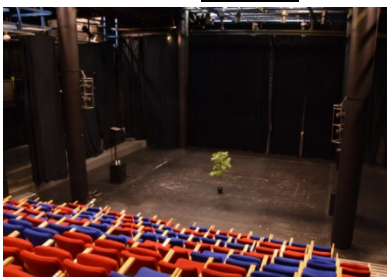
