

**VACANCY POSTING: PYP4-8 English as an Additional Language (EAL) Teacher
Mid-March through end of June 2026**

Aarhus International School (AIS) is seeking to fill a short-term position in our Primary Years Programme (PYP). We are searching for an English as an Additional Language (EAL) Teacher to join us from mid-March through the end of June 2026. The PYP EAL Teacher is a member of the Wellbeing Team at AIS and collaborates regularly to support learners in the IB Primary Years Programme. This is an 80% position.

The qualified applicant should possess knowledge and experience in supporting multilingual learners with the language acquisition process. The successful candidate will work collaboratively with classroom teachers to design and deliver engaging, inquiry-based language support for EAL students, that enables them to access the IB curriculum and develop their confidence in English. Candidates with knowledge of and teaching experience in the IB programme will be given priority. Preference will also be given to applicants who have or can obtain a legal residence in Denmark.

Responsibilities include:

- Providing targeted EAL instruction for students in PYP4-8, individually, in small groups, and providing in-lesson support in the classroom
- Collaborating with PYP colleagues to plan, co-teach, and differentiate instruction
- Supporting students' language development in listening, speaking, reading, and writing
- Facilitating language assessments and use assessment data to monitor and promote inclusion, student wellbeing, and international-mindedness
- Communicating effectively with parents/guardians regarding student progress
- Participating in school life, professional learning, and IB-related initiatives

Minimum requirements:

- B.A. degree from an accredited college or university
- Teaching certification as a primary/elementary school teacher
- Experience teaching at the lower elementary/primary level
- Familiarization with transdisciplinary teaching and inquiry-based learning
- Proficiency in ICT and its use
- Strong and effective collaboration skills
