We are seeking a qualified and trained pedagogue who is experienced and confident working with children aged 6–8, who has experience with sports activities for children, and who has a demonstrated ability to support the wellbeing and development of young learners. Strong proficiency in English is essential, as is an interest in contributing to an international school environment.
