VACANCY POSTING: PYP Homeroom Teacher

Aarhus International School (AIS) is currently accepting applications for a permanent, fulltime Homeroom Teacher for our PYP7B (grade 4) class, starting 1 August 2026.

The successful candidate will assume responsibility for a Primary Years Programme (PYP) homeroom at the upper primary level and will work collaboratively within the PYP team to deliver a high-quality, inquiry-based international education.

AIS is an authorised International Baccalaureate (IB) World School offering the PYP and MYP for students aged 3–15. The programme is built on inquiry, creativity and reflection, fostering a stimulating environment that nurtures curiosity and a lifelong love of learning.

Responsibilities include:

- Acting as homeroom teacher for our PYP7B class, including responsibility for student wellbeing, pastoral care, and parent communication
- Planning, teaching, and assessing learning in line with the IB Primary Years Programme
- Implementing inquiry-based and concept-driven learning experiences
- Collaborating closely with specialist teachers, learning support staff, and the wider PYP team
- Contributing to curriculum development, assessment practices, and school initiatives

Minimum requirements:

- A recognised bachelor's degree in education (or equivalent) from an accredited institution
- Valid teaching qualification for primary/elementary education
- Minimum three (3) years of full-time teaching experience at the primary level
- Familiarity with inquiry-based and interdisciplinary teaching
- Ability to work collaboratively as part of a team
- High level of proficiency in English

The ideal candidate demonstrates strong communication and interpersonal skills, works with flexibility and initiative, and is open to collaboration in a multicultural environment. They take a student-centred approach to teaching and learning and are committed to inclusive practices, while consistently upholding high professional and ethical standards.
